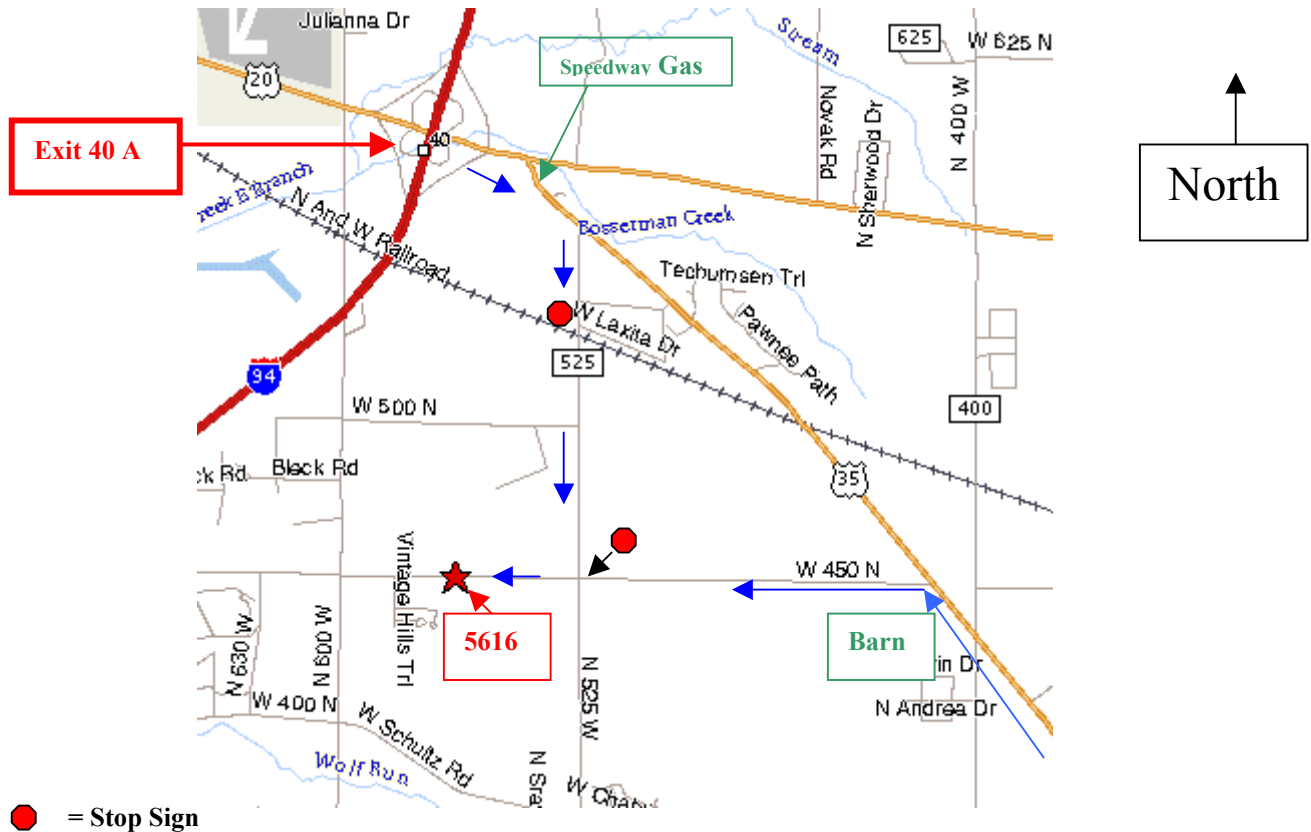

Two Methods:

From the South- Take route 35 north through Laporte- on north end of Pine Lake Route 35 and Route 39 split- stay on Route 35 to 450 N (5 miles)- white barn on your right has sign that says "Laporte Vinyard"- turn left onto 450 N and go to 5616.

Traveling East or West on I 94- Take exit 40 A- Route 35 South- 300 yards past the Speedway Gas Station is city road 525- Turn right on 525 and go to the second stop sign which is 450-turn- right on 450 and go west to 5616.
