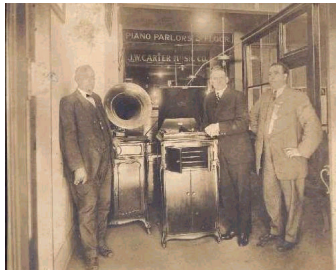


JULY MEETING NOTICE!
