Tipton, IN



- 1: Take US-31 North out of Indianapolis or South out of Kokomo.
- 2: Turn (east) off of 31 onto IN-28 / W 200 S. Continue to follow IN-28. 3.4 miles
- 3: Turn RIGHT onto W 200 S / W IN-28. 0.5 miles
- 4: W 200 S / W IN-28 becomes CEMETARY RD. 0.2 miles
- 5: Turn RIGHT to stay on CEMETARY RD. 0.1 miles
- 6: Turn RIGHT onto W SOUTH ST. 0.1 miles
- 7: End at 323 W South St- Tipton Historical Society
